A Simple Model of Children's Harp & Bowl

Children in the House of Prayer

Your children's prayer team might be a part of a House of Prayer or it might be a children's house of prayer or it might be a part of a church, or an orphanage or a school or it might be with children in your neighborhood or street children.

The Harp & Bowl Model is a model of worship with intercession that is used at the international house of prayer in Kansas City – IHOP KC and many houses of prayer. We have simplified this model in order to make it accessible for children.



Talking to God in Prayer

Using Scriptures about Prayer:

We can teach the children what God says about prayer in His special book, the Bible. We can teach them scripture memory verses about prayer:

Jeremiah 33:3 Call to Me and I will answer...



They can learn that God really likes for them to talk to Him in prayer and that Jesus said in **Matthew 7:7-8:**

Ask, and it will be given to you...For everyone who asks, receives...

We can explain to the children that Prayer (talking to God) is so important that **Jesus spent all night in prayer**: (Luke 6:12-13)

And that He often withdrew into the wilderness and prayed:

Luke 5:16 So He Himself often withdrew into the wilderness and prayed.

And that **Jesus taught His disciples to pray:** Jesus said:

After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

10Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.

11Give us this day our daily bread.

12And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

13And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen. Matthew 6:9-13

Children's Prayer Sheet



During these prayer times, we are going to be praying for our nations!

Basic Prayer Information:

Jesus said we can ask him anything in His name and He will do it. (If you shall ask anything in My Name, I will do it. John 14:14) He also said we can ask the Father anything in His name. (...if you ask the Father for anything in My name, He will give it to you... John16:23) So, we pray in the name of Jesus.

Jesus told us to pray to the Father, in the name of Jesus, so you could say something like this:

Father, in the name of Jesus, I ask for Revival in my nation.



Call on God

In the Bible, God said that we can call on Him and He will answer! Call on Me and I will answer...(Jeremiah 33:3a)


Ask and it will be given to you...(Matthew 7:7)



We stand on the word of God!

Jesus said, I am the way the truth and the life no man comes unto the Father but by Me. (John 14:6)

Jesus is the Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9:6) We can pray for Jesus to bring peace to our nations.




We can pray for Jesus to be Lord over our nations.

We can invite Jesus to come to our nations, because Jesus said, "I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly." (John 10:10) So, Jesus can bring abundant life to our nations. He can bring salvation to our nations.

The Bible also tells us that we are to pray for all of the leaders and all who are in authority in our nation. That means that we are to pray for the president, governors, mayors, and others who lead our nations. 1 Timothy 2: 1-2

This is the victory that overcomes the world, even our faith.

1John 5:4) So, we are to ask in faith believing that God will answer us!



...We are more than conquerors through Him that loved us. (Romans 8:37)

We've been given the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (... Thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ! 1 Corinthians 15:57)

If God is for us, who can be against us! (Romans 8:31)

Info to Share with Children about Children's Prayer Teams:

Boys and Girls, I would like to tell you about what some children are doing around the world. There are children who are a part of children's prayer teams. God even shows them how to pray for nations. And some children are even going to nations to pray, going to other cities to help to train other children to pray. Children are a key to what God wants to do in cities and nations!

Children's prayers can be so strong. God loves to hear the prayers of children. Your prayers can be so important in changing a family, a city or even a nation.

In fact, the Bible says that children are like arrows:

As arrows are in the hand of a mighty man; so are children of the youth. Psalm 127:4


Resources to Share with Children about Children's Prayer Teams:

More Stories about Children and Prayer:

The following stories are true stories about children and prayer that can be an encouragement to you. My great-grandson really enjoyed these stories. I just omitted the sentence about brothels in the story about Surabaya.

Seeing Children as God Sees Them

When you look at children, what do you see? Do you see them as secret weapons in God's heavenly arsenal? Do you believe God can use them to impact our world?

Here's how God sees the role of children in praise and spiritual warfare: "From the lips of children and infants you have ordained praise because of your enemies, to silence the foe and the avenger" (Ps. 8:2).

At the World Prayer Assembly in Indonesia in May 2012, 15-year-old Daisey told her story. Daisey is from Surabaya, the second largest city in Indonesia, and she grew up in a part of the city filled with prostitution, gangs, and drugs.

But local Christians saw the children as part of the answer to the plight of the city. These believers began to train the children in prayer. They taught them how God could give them power to pray and to see their community transformed. What began with ten children meeting once a week to pray for two hours, grew to 20 children meeting two times a week. They prayer walked their community and invited God to come. They prayed over neighborhood maps, praying the Scriptures and agreeing with God's plan.

One by one the brothels began to close. A national newspaper wrote about the transformation of the community. Today it is a safe place for children to play.

Do you believe God can use children? In Indonesia tens of thousands of children have been trained as intercessors. In neighboring Singapore a movement called Arise is raising up children in worship and prayer.

In Chennai, India, God called Anton Cruz to see destitute children with new eyes. Today, as part of the Royal Kids Ministry, more than 8,000 children are a spiritual force in their community. They even have their own television program watched by two million children each week.

In Bihar, India's poorest state, God is using orphan girls as world-changers, full of joy and love for God. Praying with them has changed the way I see children today. Whole villages have come to Christ through their witness. Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these" (Matt. 19:14).



Information on Curriculum and Children's Lessons

1. The Wordless Book:




The **Wordless Book** is a good basic resource that can be used to teach children some foundational teachings using a fun and easy method. The **Wordless Book uses colors** to share the gospel with children.

First is the gold page. This page talks about God. It talks about how God is the creator of Heaven and Earth and then I usually ask the children, "What else did God create?" And the children have so much fun raising their hands and sharing! One might say dogs and the other one might say trees and another one might say flowers, Etc.

So it gives the children a basic understanding that God is the creator. And then it talks about heaven and how wonderful heaven is. But you know there's one thing that can't be in heaven and that is sin! So, then you show them the dark page and say this page reminds me of sin and the Bible says that "all have sinned and come short of the glory of God." Uh-oh I want to go to heaven but I've sinned. What can I do? Well, this red page reminds me that Jesus died on the cross for me so I could receive forgiveness for my sins and be able to go to Heaven someday! And this white page reminds me that when His blood cleanses me from my sins, my heart becomes white as snow. And at this time you can give the children an opportunity to receive Jesus as their Savior to make their hearts white and clean so that they can go to Heaven someday. I also use the Jesus gift. I have a present that's wrapped really nicely with a beautiful bow and a picture of Jesus inside and explain that Jesus is a special gift to us that allows us to go to heaven someday. Then the green page explains to the children how to grow spiritually by reading the Bible, praying, going to church, Etc. Then I always share the blue page also and I talk about how the Holy Spirit helps us to become more like Jesus, to follow in his footsteps. And I give them an opportunity to pray and receive the Holy Spirit also.

So it's a very simple tool to use and allows the children to learn some important foundational truths.

The following book is the true story of a boy in Africa who receives salvation through the Wordless Book.

3. Kids Pray! By Jane Mackie

Prayer Basics

As you are preparing your lessons for your children, it is so important to seek God as to what your children need to hear and teach them what God shows you.

It is also so important to make sure our children get a firm foundation in the Word of God. Because Jesus has warned us that in the last days there will be much deception. So, we need to make sure that our children know the truth of the Word of God.

So one way you can do that is to add a bible story that corresponds to the topic that you are teaching your children. **KidStory** has many lessons that teach children the Word of God and Bible Stories. Please see information about **KidStory** in the previous page.

Simple Sample Lessons

Sample Lesson about Prayer:

Examples of types of things that can be used in a children's lesson about Prayer:

Memory Verse:

Our scripture memory verse for today is from the Bible. It is Jeremiah 33:3a: Call to Me and I will answer...

Lesson:

Boys and Girls, we are going to talk about Prayer. Who knows what prayer is?

Yes, you are right! Prayer is talking to God, isn't it? And today we are going to talk about talking to Father God. You remember that we talked about the 3 persons in one God. Kind of like the 3 parts of my finger. You remember, there is Father God, His Son, Lord Jesus, and the Holy Spirit. So, Father God is a perfect Father that loves each one of us very much. You know, God is very powerful. He created (or made) the whole earth—the sun, the moon, the sky, the trees. And even you and me! He's the mighty God! There is nothing He can't do. The Bible says that nothing is too hard for Him. That's amazing, isn't it? Nothing is too hard for Him!! And you know what? He loves to hear you talk to Him. He loves to hear you pray to Him. You know, when my children call me on the phone, I love to talk to them. And you know, God is like that—He loves to talk to His children. And you are His child! So, He loves it when you talk to Him. He loves to hear YOU pray to Him. The Bible says that He's attentive and listening to your prayers. Did you know that? You know, you, can talk to God about anything. You can tell Him if you are sad.

You can pray for your Mommy or your Daddy. You can talk to Him about anything that's on your heart.

And, did you know that the Bible says that when you call to God, He will answer? You know, sometimes when I call my friends, they are busy and they don't answer the phone. Sometimes I get a message that says, "Please call back" or please leave a message. Or I might get an answering machine. But you know what? That never happens when you call on God! He's never too busy to talk to you. You will never get an answering machine that says, "Please call back, I'm too busy now." He's always there for you! He will always answer you because He loves you so very much and He wants to hear you talk to Him. So, we can call on God anytime. We can pray to God anytime day or night! The Bible says that He never sleeps or slumbers.

Holy Spirit You are welcome Here

Lesson:

Boys and Girls, this dove reminds me of the Holy Spirit. (show dove) The Bible says that when Jesus was being baptized, the Holy Spirit came upon Him in the form of a dove. That is the reason that we use a dove to represent the Holy Spirit. Do you know that there are 3 persons that

make up our Holy God? They are God the Father, God the Son, Who is Jesus, and God the Holy Spirit. It is kind of like your finger. My finger has 3 parts to it, but it is one finger. (show on your finger) We learned about God the Father yesterday and how He sent His only Son, Jesus, to be our Savior. Now, today, we will learn about God the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit is the One Who will come to help you as you learn to follow in Jesus' footsteps and He will help you to become more like Jesus. He is the One Who will help us to know Jesus better—to know Jesus as our friend and to develop a closer relationship with Him. You know that Jesus doesn't want you to just know about Him, He wants you to know Him as your best friend. So, the Holy Spirit helps us to know Jesus as our friend.

Did you know that Jesus calls the Holy Spirit the gift that the Father God promised. So, the Holy Spirit is a very special gift to us from God the Father. You remember in our Memory Verse that Jesus breathed on His disciples and told them to, "receive the Holy Spirit."

Jesus said to His disciples,..."You shall receive power after the Holy Spirit comes upon you."

So, the Holy Spirit is our Power Source.(show visual) The word that the Bible uses when talking about the power that the Holy Spirit gives us is "dunamis." This is the same word that "dynamite" comes from (show dynamite visual) And you know that dynamite is very powerful—it can blow

up whole big buildings. But, Holy Spirit is much more powerful than dynamite. The Bible says that the Holy Spirit brooded over the waters to create the earth. And it is by the Holy Spirit's power that people are able to do mighty miracles. The Bible says that when the Spirit came upon Samson, he was able to pull down an entire building. And Jesus says in the Bible that it is by the anointing of the Holy Spirit that He was able to heal people....

Did you know that the Bible says that we are to be "filled with the Holy Spirit?"

Object Lessons.

If we are filled with something, what does that mean? For instance, if this glass is filled with water (or KoolAid), it means that there is water all the way up to the top! It is filled. (pour a very little water from pitcher into glass. Is this glass filled with water? No!! It just has a little bit! Then pour just a little bit more, and ask, "Is this glass filled with water? No!! Not yet!!! Then a little bit more and ask again. Then—all the way to the top—even to overflowing! Then ask—is this glass filled? Yes!!! We are to be filled with the Holy Spirit!

You can remind the children that Jesus calls the Holy Spirit, the gift that the Father promised. You can use a wrapped present or gift bag as a visual or object to remind the children that the Holy Spirit is a gift for them. Then lead the children in asking Jesus to baptize them in His Holy Spirit.

Create in Me a Clean Heart Lesson

Opening Prayer:

Possible Songs:

- What Can Wash Away My Sin—Nothing but the Blood of Jesus…
- Alleluia

Scripture Memory Verse:

***To keep with the theme of a clean heart, we usually bring a clothesline with clothespins and pin the separate parts of the scripture onto the clothesline.



The Bible says that we are to hide God's Word in our hearts that we might not sin against God. So, right now we are going to hide God's Word in our heart by learning a scripture verse. This scripture is from the Bible:

Psalm 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O God...

Salmos 51:10 Crea en mí, oh Dios, un corazón limpio

Lesson:

Many of you have received Jesus as your Savior. When we receive Jesus as our Savior, the Bible says that we become new creations and that old things pass away and all things become new. That means our old sinful nature

and sinful desires pass away and we become new from the inside out (***show caterpillar)—kind of like a caterpillar becomes a butterfly (***open caterpillar that opens up to become a butterfly). The butterfly is a brand new creature.

So, we become a new creation with a brand new heart (***show large white heart that has been laminated)—a heart and a desire to follow God instead of our old sinful desires. Instead of having an old dirty heart filled with sin. we get a brand new heart and we feel fresh and clean. (***Show children the big, white heart). Our "want to's" change. We don't even want to do those old sinful things that we used to want to do. Instead, we want to do things that will please God—we become interested in reading the Bible(***show Bible)—the Bible becomes alive to us. (***Open large Bible prop with visual Inside). We find that we want to spend time with Jesus and talk to Him and get to know Him. We find that we want to come to the House of Prayer to learn more about our friend, Jesus. So, boys and girls, if you have received Jesus, you have become a brand new creation with a brand new heart.

And, of course, we want to keep our hearts beautiful and pure and clean before God. We want to obey God's rules that are in the Bible, so that we can keep our hearts beautiful and pure.

So, what happens if we do make a mistake and sin? When we disobey God's rules, it is called sin and did you know that sin makes our hearts dirty? Who can tell me

some things that are sin? (Mark large white heart with dark marker as the children tell of things that are sin). And, did you know that the Bible says that sin separates us from God? So, we need to get rid of sin right away!

So, what can we do if we have sin in our hearts or sin in our lives? So, what can we do to make our heart clean again? (Show the children detergent or a bar of soap) Can we put our hearts in the wash tub or washing machine and put in lots of soap or detergent and make them clean again? NO! But the Bible does tell us what we can do to cleanse our hearts again. The Bible says, "If we confess our sins, God is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness." Unrighteousness is wrong things and anything that is disobedient to God's laws.

So, if we sin, we need to repent—that means to turn from our sinful ways and to make a decision to go God's way instead. And, we need to confess our sins to God right away and ask Him to forgive us for those sins. We need to make a decision that we will not do those things again. (***Show cross visual) The Bible also says that the Blood of Jesus cleanses us from all sin. So, after we confess our sins to God, we can ask Jesus to make our hearts clean again with His precious blood.

When we choose to obey God's rules and invite Jesus to help us keep our hearts clean and pure and we confess our sins to God right away, He can cleanse our hearts, it makes us have pure and beautiful hearts before God. Let us take some time and repent for any sin in our lives. Let's cry out to God, "Create in me a clean heart, O God." So, if you can think of any sin in your life, right now you can ask God to forgive you for these sins.

David, A Man After God's Own Heart

Scripture Memory Verse:

Lesson:

Today we are going to talk about a very special person that we find in God's Special Book (show Bible Visual or Bible). What's the name of this special book? Yes, you are right! It's the Bible!

So, today we are going to talk about someone who began to serve God when he was very young—maybe even your age. Today we are going to talk about David.

The Bible says that David had a heart after God's own heart. (show big red heart) How did David get a heart after God's own heart? I want a heart after God's own heart! Do you want a heart after God's own heart? So, how did David get a heart after God's own heart?

The Bible says that while David was a young boy, he was a shepherd. Who can tell me what a shepherd is? Yes, a shepherd is someone who takes care of sheep (show lamb or lamb visual). So, the Bible says that David took care of his Father's sheep out in the field. Do you know what else David did while he was out in the field taking care of his father's sheep? He spent time talking to God and worshipping God with his harp. Do you know what a harp is boys and girls? This is a sample. (show harp or visual). Well, David would play his harp to God and sing beautiful songs to God. He developed such a personal relationship, such a close and deep relationship with God. He had a heart that responded to God's call for a very close and personal relationship with God. You know, we learned that God is like a very good Father—the best father—and He likes it when we come and spend time with Him, doesn't He? You know when my children don't come and visit me and come spend time with me, it makes me sad. I wonder if it makes God sad when we don't come to visit Him and spend time with Him. I don't know, but I do know that He really likes it when we come to spend time with Him!

There might be times when you feel that Father God or Lord Jesus is wanting you to come and talk or come spend time. So, whenever we feel that, what do we do? Do we say, "I don't have time right now, I'm busy playing with my friend" or do we say, "Yes, Lord. I will come spend time with You." What do you think that David did? I think that David answered God and said Yes to God right away. I think that David loved God so much that he wanted to spend a lot of time with Him.

David spent time with God out in the fields when no one else was around. He really got to know God. David became God's friend. David began to know God so well that he knew what God liked, and what God didn't like. He began to know what was important to God. David made God his priority—the most important thing in his life. He was seeking after God with his whole heart.


And do you know what happened? When God needed a new king for Israel, even though David was only a young boy—maybe even your own age—God chose him to be anointed to be the next king of Israel. Isn't that amazing, boys and girls? Because of David's heart for God, he was chosen to be king of the whole nation of Israel while he was still a child like you. Here is a picture of the prophet Samuel anointing David to become King of Israel. You know, boys and girls, God didn't choose David to become king of Israel because he was smart or good looking or because he had a lot of money. He chose David because David was seeking after God with his whole heart.

Now boys and girls, we're going to have our altar time. That's our special time with God—our special time in His Presence. Today during our altar time, I want you to talk to God about your relationship with Him. Do you take time to talk to God and spend time with Him each day. Are you seeking after God with your whole heart like David did?

Now boys and girls, let's talk to God, let's go into our **secret place** that we have to talk to Him. Kneel down and bow your heads all the way down, so you won't get distracted and you will be able to hear what God has to say to you, you can hear His voice even when you are among other children or other people.
